# November VCCA Monthly Meeting

The VCCA Monthly meeting will be **Monday, November** 

**10th at 7:00 PM** at Café Ginger, located at 1952 West Gray Street in the shopping center near the intersection with Driscoll.

Have you had to deal with unwanted wildlife on or around your property? Squirrels, opossums, and raccoons are common in the VCCA area which can result in household issues. The November 10th speaker, Bonnie Brad-



shaw of 911 Wildlife, will discuss simple, effective ways to solve urban wildlife problems without ever setting a trap. **911 Wildlife** is a service that uses a different approach to wildlife and animal removal. No traps or



chemicals of any kind are used. Specially designed one-way doors are installed to prevent animals from being trapped inside attics and chimneys or under foundations. Educational information on preventing wildlife problems is provided to every customer.

**911 Wildlife** exclusively uses techniques endorsed by the Humane Society of the United States, Houston SPCA, Bat Conservation International, and the Wildlife Center of Texas. These techniques have been used successfully for more than 25 years. Come to the meeting to hear more.
