Our neighborhood has not one but two Little Free Libraries. One is found on the southeast side at Indiana and Morse, 1949 Indiana. The second is located at Haddon and McDuffie, 1614-2 McDuffie. The libraries are small boxes where you are welcome to take a book, leave a book you no longer

want, or both! There are usually children's books and adult books - some fiction, some non-fiction. It is a perfect stop on a dog walk, or a people walk! The "Little Free Library" movement came to the United States in 2009 and now boasts more than 30,000

easy and can save money on fertilizer

when it comes time to start your garden after the cold season.

Almost everything in your vard is compostable (grass and plant clippings, leaves, dead or brown weeds), except for weeds that have seeds or pernicious weeds (e.g., ivy) that can with-

John and Anna Doody are the proud home owners at 2116 Brun. The longtime residents have created a beautiful architectural design for their huge front yard.






Boundaries of the VCCA
