GIFT CARD SCAM

It has come to our attention that someone contacted several residents asking them to purchase gift cards for a charity on behalf of the VCCA. This is a commonly used scam tactic. Please know that the VCCA would never tell our residents to do this. If you receive an email requesting you to purchase gift cards for the VCCA, another organization, or even someone from your job - use extreme caution. If you believe the request to be legitimate, it is best to call the person making the request to be sure!

ABANDONED CARS

If a car has been parked on your street and not moved for more than a week, call the Constable or HPD. They will put a tag on the car and then check back in a few days. If it has not moved, they will have it towed.
