Restaurant News!

One of the pleasures of being in our neighborhood is being within walking distance of great shopping and dining! Several new restaurants have opened within walking distance of Vermont Commons. Walk there and let them know you are from the neighborhood!!

Ever driven by Men's Wearhouse on West Gray and Driscoll and wonder about all the construction that was going on? It turns out the construction was not on Men's Wearhouse, but a new restaurant on the second floor! It is called Albi, which means "my heart" in Arabic. "The upscale restaurant arrives with a menu marrying Lebanese, Turkish, and Greek cuisines from consulting chef Mark Cox, who Houston diners know from his many years helming Mark's American Cuisine. Cox, working with executive chef Christian Hernandez, formerly chef de cuisine of March, have created a menu inspired by the Levant region of the Middle East with dishes such as shrimp falafel with heirloom tomatoes, beets with yogurt and pickled berries, tuna tartare with Aleppo peppers and apricot coulis, trumpet mushroom shawarma with tzatziki sauce, Texas wagyu steaks, kebabs and seafood, and jidori chicken roulade stuffed with sausage and golden raisins. For dessert there's lemon halva tart with olive oil ice cream, Basque cheesecake, and pistachio tiramisu" (Houston Chronicle May 5, Greg Morano).

Cocody is "a contemporary fine-dining restaurant & bar situated on one of the most prestigious streets in Houston, Texas, West Gray. The restaurant will have a chef's table, lounge bar, patio seating, and a beautifully-designed main dining room. We are passionate about gastronomy, food, cocktails, and art."
