AROUND THE NEIGHBORHOOD

Have you noticed the Precinct 1 Constable patrol signs at the entrances to our neighborhood and the Constable vehicles patrolling our neighborhood? The Constable patrol has been in our neighborhood for over 8 years helping to improve the security of our neighborhood.

It takes financial support from all our neighbors to fund this important security and safety service but, only 25-30% of our neighbors are currently supporting the Constable Patrol. However, all our neighbors benefit because <u>without</u> a contract in place, the Constable would <u>NOT</u> be in our neighborhood or respond to calls in our neighborhood. Constable patrols are <u>NOT</u> standard taxpayer funded services.

If you are not already a Constable patrol member, please consider joining your neighbors to support the program. The annual cost is only \$300.

- o Faster non-emergency law enforcement response
- Establishing the Constable as law enforcement home alarm response- improved response time
- Vacation Watch Service
- Yard signs indicating membership in the program
